Transmission control guidelines for community settings incorporated many of the same types of measures for containing the spread of SARS as 12 recommended for health care settings. CDC published SARS transmission control guidelines for two community settings the workplace and households. The workplace guidelines recommended frequent hand washing with soap and water or waterless alcohol-based hand rubs. Along with handwashing, guidelines for household transmission control included the following: Infection control precautions should be continued for SARS patients for 10 days after respiratory symptoms and fever are gone. SARS patients should limit interactions outside the home and should not go to work, school, out-of-home day care, or other public areas during the 10-day period. During this 10-day period, each patient with SARS should cover his or her...
